# One: Trust The Right Things What Trust Means:

Trusting assumes something is reliable.
Trusting places confidence in another.
Trusting means we feel safe physically & emotionally.
What trusting God means:

- -While facing *life* in a *real* way.
- -We continue to turn to Him.
- -And away from naysayers.

### **What Are The Right Things**

### 1. RT's start with Jesus.

John 1:12 Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God—

### 2. RT's are to *listen* to Him & *follow* Him.

John 10:27 My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

### 3. RT's are to be *good people*.

Gal 6:10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.

### 4. RT's are to live a life of love.

John 13:34 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.

# One: Trust The Right Things Two: Be Faithful To Those RT's What Faithful Means:

Faithfulness is the act of being *loyal* or *devoted*. Faithful is *standing* by our *promises*.

### When We're Faithful To The RT's

### 1. When faithful Jesus ends up honored.

1 Cor 4:2 Now it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful.

### 2. When faithful we reap well.

Galatians 6:7 Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.

### 3. When faithful it builds a great life.

Proverbs 25:13 Like the coolness of snow at harvest time is a trustworthy messenger to those who send him; he refreshes the spirit of his masters.

Matthew 25:21 "His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come

## Two Things for Us To Be Encouraged.

1. One: *Trust* the *right* things!

and share your master's happiness!'

- 2. Two: Be faithful to those right things!
- 3. Otherwise we end up:
  - -Questioning things regularly.
  - -Doubting ourselves often.
