How To Receive God's Righteousness
(1) my righteousness for salvation. Phil 3:9 and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law,
(2) out to God by Phil 3:9 but that which is through faith in Christ— Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
