What This Life Looks Like

Phil 3:11 and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead.

- (1) Live with the *motivating hope* of my salvation. Acts 4:12 Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved." 13 When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and they took note that these men had been with Jesus.
- (2) Live with joy because of being heaven bound. Hebrews 6:18 we who have fled to take hold of the hope set before us may be greatly encouraged. 19 We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain, 20 where our forerunner, Jesus, has entered on our behalf. He has become a high priest forever,

2 Peter 3:13 But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth

2. No more sad emotions in heaven.

Rev 21:4 'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."

3. No more bad behavior in heaven.

Rev 21:27 Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful,

4. No more night in heaven - God lights it.

Rev 22:5 There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light.

5. Heaven will have a different value system.

Rev 21:18 The wall was made of jasper, and the city of pure gold, as pure as glass. 19 The foundations of the city walls were decorated with every kind of precious stone.
