1. Jesus is the one doing the evaluating.

Rev 2:1 "To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: "These are the words of him who holds the seven stars in his right hand and walks among the seven golden lampstands.

2. Jesus commends them.

- (1) They did *good* things & worked hard. Rev 2:2 I know your deeds, your hard work and your perseverance.
- (2) They understood truth & protected it.
 Rev 2:2 I know that you cannot tolerate wicked people, that you have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them false.
- (3) They didn't walk away when persecuted. Rev 2:3 You have persevered and have endured hardships for my name, and have not grown weary.
- (4) You refused to embrace immorality. Rev 2:6 But you have this in your favor: You hate the practices of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.

3. Jesus also fills them in on their failures.

(1) You've *given* up the *love* you had for Me. Rev 2:4 Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken the love you had at first.

(2) Forgetfulness can bring on spiritual decline.

How To Get Back On Our Feet Again

- 1. Remember what it was like before.
- Rev 2:5 Consider how far you have fallen!
- 2. Repent and be willing to change Rev 2:5 . . . Repent
- 3, Repeat what you did at first. Rev 2:5 . . . and do the things you did at first.
- (3) Being without love shuts our light down.
 Rev 2:5 If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place.

How To Get Back To Love

- 1. Tell Jesus you love Him.
- 2. Take what He says seriously.
- 3. Begin trusting Him more completely.
- 4. *Look* for Him to *show* up in your life.
- 5. Talk about Him regularly.

4. Jesus rewards listening & following.

- (1) Stay honest & receptive to what Jesus says. Rev 2:7 Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches.
- **(2)** Safety is a reality for Jesus followers. Rev 2:7 To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.
