Church 1 Ephesus:

We must know of Gods love - To love Him back!

Church 2 Smyrna:

They were *rich* - Because they knew their *future*!

Church 3 Pergamum:

Some stood strong - Hidden manna & assurance! Some went the worlds way - They listened to evil!

Church 4 Thyatira

They were tolerating evil - Gave time to change! Stay away from evil - Hold on to Me!

Church 5 Sardis

People thought they were *alive* spiritually! But in reality they were *dead* - Had *work* to do!

1. Jesus takes a *look* at Philadelphia.

Rev 3:7 "To the angel of the church in Philadelphia write

- (1) So what about Philadelphia?
 - 1. Founded 189 BC.
 - 2. By King Eumenes & brother Atttalus II.
 - 3. Philly was a gateway to The East.
 - 4. Had fertile soil & was known for vineyards.
 - 5. The earthquake in 17 AD rocked them.
 - 6. After that event many lived *outside* city.

(2) Jesus gives this message.

Four aspects of who Jesus is

1. He who is *holy*.

Rev 3:7 "These are the words of him who is holy . . .

2. He who is *true*.

Rev 3:7 "... and true,

3. He who has the key of David.

Rev 3:7 "... who holds the key of David

4. He opens doors that can't be shut.

Rev 3:7 ". . . What he opens no one can shut, and what he shuts no one can open

2. Jesus lays out some big wins for Philly.

Rev 3:8 I know your deeds.

(1) You have little strength - Yet mighty.

Rev 3:8 . . . I know that you have little strength, . . .

(2) You have kept my word.

Rev 3:8 . . . yet you have kept my word . . .

(3) You've not denied my name.

Rev 3:8 . . . and have not denied my name

3. Jesus offers them great *promises*.

(1) Three huge future realities for them.

1. They would be fruitful.

Rev 3:8 . . . I have placed before you an open door that no one can shut. . .

2. They would be secure.

Rev 3:9 I will make those who are of the synagogue of Satan, who claim to be Jews though they are not, but are liars—I will make them come and fall down at your feet . . .

3. They would be *vindicated*.

Rev 3:9 . . . and acknowledge that I have loved you.

(2) The pay off for hanging in with Jesus.

Rev 3:10 Since you have kept my command to endure patiently, . . .

1. I will keep you from something.

Rev 3:10 I will also keep you . . .

2. You will *not* experience the tribulation.

Rev 3:10 . . . the hour of trial that is going to come on the whole world . . .

3. The tribulation will test the earth.

Rev 3:10 . . . to test the inhabitants of the earth.

4. Jesus tells them - I am coming back.

Rev 3:11 I am coming soon . . .

4. The advice Jesus gives them & us.

(1) Protect the rewards you've earned.

Rev 3:11 . . . Hold on to what you have, so that no one will take your crown.

(2) Sign up to be an overcomer.

Rev 3:2 The one who is victorious

1. We become a *pillar* for God.

Rev 3:12 I will make a pillar in the temple of my God. Never again will they leave it. . .

2. We get the name of God.

Rev 3:12 I will write on them the name of my God . .

3. We get the name of the *city* of God.

Rev 3:12 . . . and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which is coming down out of heaven from my God; . . .

4. We get His new name.

Rev 3:12 and I will also write on them my new name.

Rev 3:13 Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches.
