Part 1 CC - Doyle Surratt

- 1. We contrasted Mary & Eve.
- (1) As to their response to God.
- (2) Eve wanted more than she had.
- (3) Mary followed & accepted things.
- (4) Mary wanted: "A different kind of more".
- 2. Mary's calling was unique & lasting.
- (1) Mary was called by God to serve.
- (2) Mary had a unique pregnancy.
- (3) Mary was chosen to birth Jesus.
- (4) Mary was called to a life of ministry.

Acts 1:14 They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.

- 1. To help build the church.
- 2. To live a real life following Jesus.
- 3. People listened when she *spoke*.

Part 2 CC - Jim Mackinga

- 1. Beside being the *first* what about Adam.
- (1) Adam listened to his wife (After she's set up).
- (2) Adam wanted to be close to his wife.
- (3) Adam ignored the command God gave.
- (4) Adam faced a grocery list of human issues.
 - 1. Pride Ambition & Self-focus.
 - 2. Raw human unbelief.
 - 3. Ungrateful for what he had.

2. What about Joseph the step-dad?

- (1) Joseph was a good & tenderhearted man. Matt 1:19 Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly.
- (2) Joseph was willing to *listen* to God. Matt 1:24 When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife.
- (3) Joseph was a hard-working craftsman. Matt 13:55 "Isn't this the carpenter's son? Isn't his mother's name Mary, and aren't his brothers James, Joseph, Simon and Judas?
- (4) Joseph again listened to warning & fled. Matt 2:13 When they had gone, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream. "Get up," he said, "take the child and his mother and escape to Egypt. Stay there until I tell you, for Herod is going to search for the child to kill him." 14 So he got up, took the child and his mother during the night and left for Egypt,
 - 1. Joseph didn't delay.
 - 2. Joseph didn't blame anyone.
 - 3. Joseph got up & did what was asked.
- (5) When the *threat is* neutralized he *listens*. Matt 2:20 and said, "Get up, take the child and his mother and go to the land of Israel, for those who were trying to take the child's life are dead." 21 So he got up, took the child and his mother and went to the land of Israel.
