"Jesus Saves In The Trib!"

Part 18 January 29, 2023

1. John moves to a new vision.

Rev 7:9 After this . . .

(1) After the big *pause* (Rev 7:1-7).

(2) During that time - The 144,000 are installed.

(3) Time frame *between* visions is *unknown*.

2. John sees an enormous group.

(1) This enormous group was *uncountable*.

Rev 7:9... I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count,

(2) TEG: Was from all over the world.

Rev 7:9 . . . from every nation, tribe, people and language,

(3) TEG: Was definitely sealed in heaven.

Rev 7:9 . . . standing before the throne and before the Lamb. They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands

(4) TEG: Was honoring God all out.

Rev 7:10 And they cried out in a loud voice: "Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb."

3. God is appropriately *lifted* high.

(1) Angels wonderfully love & honor God.

Rev 7:11 All the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures.

(2) Their posture is deserved & comfortable.

Rev 7:11 They fell down on their faces before the throne and worshiped God,

(3) Their words of praise flow easy.

Rev 7:12 saying: "Amen! Praise and glory and wisdom and thanks and honor and power and strength be to our God for ever and ever. Amen!"

4. This vast group of people are identified.

(1) A question is posed to John by an elder.

Rev 7:13 Then one of the elders asked me, "These in white robes — who are they, and where did they come from?"

(2) John: Not my first *rodeo* - Don't *tease* me. Rev 7:14 I answered, "Sir, you know."

(3) This elder goes on to explain *who* they *are*.

Rev 7:14 And he said, "These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

(4) People who were *killed* in the *tribulation*. What do they get/receive?

1. They get to serve Him (Dead people)!

Rev 7:15 Therefore, "they are before the throne of God and serve him day and night in his temple;

2. They will be forever protected by Him (Safe)!

Rev 7:15... and he who sits on the throne will shelter them with his presence. 16 'Never again will they hunger; never again will they thirst. The sun will not beat down on them,'

3. Jesus was *with* **them** (If only we *got* this now). Rev 7:17 For the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd; 'he will lead them to springs of living water.'

4. We'll experience no more *sadness* (*Gone*)**.** Rev 7:17 And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.'"
