Rev 8:6 Then the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared to sound them.

1. The *first* trumpet *fires* up.

(1) Again we have something thrown at *earth*.

Rev 8:7 The first angel sounded his trumpet, and there came hail and fire mixed with blood, and it was hurled down on the earth. . . .

(2) One third of the earth was *destroyed*.

Rev 8: 7 . . . A third of the earth was burned up, . . .

(3) One third of all *trees* were destroyed.

Rev 8:7 . . . a third of the trees were burned up, . . .

(4) All *grass* was destroyed.

Rev 8:7 . . . and all the green grass was burned up.

2. The *second* trumpet is *heard*.

(1) Some kind of *meteor* was thrown to the *sea*.

Rev 8:8 The second angel sounded his trumpet, and something like a huge mountain, all ablaze, was thrown into the sea. . . .

(2) A third of the *sea* *die* and end up as *blood*.

Rev 8:8 . . . A third of the sea turned into blood, . . .

(3) One third of *fish, boats & crews* wiped out.

Rev 8:9 . . . a third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

3. The *third* trumpet *comes* to life.

(1) Something even *bigger* than T2 *fell* to earth.

Rev 8:10 The third angel sounded his trumpet, and a great star, blazing like a torch, fell from the sky

(2) It *destroyed* a *third* of fresh water on earth.

Rev 8:10 on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water—11 the name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters turned bitter, . . .

(3) Many *died* as a result of *poisoned* water.

Rev 8:11 . . . and many people died from the waters that had become bitter.

4. The *fourth* trumpet *rings* out.

(1) The *changes* here happened in *space*.

Rev 8:12 The fourth angel sounded his trumpet,

1. The *sun* was impacted.

. . . and a third of the sun was struck . . .

2. The *moon* was impacted.

. . . a third of the moon, . . .

3. The *stars* were impacted.

. . . and a third of the stars,

(2) The *blessing* of what God *created* was less.

Rev 8:12 . . . so that a third of them turned dark. . . .

(3) God *blended* this curse to produce *darkness*.

Rev 8:12 . . . A third of the day was without light, and also a third of the night.

An eagle makes an announcement

Rev 8:13 As I watched, I heard an eagle that was flying in midair call out in a loud voice: “Woe! Woe! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the trumpet blasts about to be sounded by the other three angels!”
