"Trumpet 6 - Woe Two"

"The Future - From Jesus"

Rev 9:12 The first woe is past; two other woes are yet to come.

- 1. The 6th trumpet gets *under* way.
- (1) John hears a distinct *voice* in his vision. Rev 9:13 The sixth angel sounded his trumpet, and I heard a voice . . .
- (2) The location of the voice is the *altar*. Rev 9:13 . . . coming from the four horns of the golden altar that is before God.
- 2. To begin a massive judgment on earth.
- (1) The first move is to *release* these 4 angels. Rev 9:14 It said to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates."
- (2) These bad angels set out on a mission.
 Rev 9:15 And the four angels who had been kept ready for this very hour and day and month and year were released to kill a third of mankind.
- (3) 200 million troops made up of demons. Rev 9:16 The number of the mounted troops was twice ten thousand times ten thousand. I heard their number.
- 3. What this army & life looks like.
- (1) The riders & horses were fierce.
 Rev 9:17 The horses and riders I saw in my vision looked like this: Their breastplates were fiery red, dark blue, and yellow as sulfur.

(2) The horses spit out deadly stuff.

Rev 9:17 The heads of the horses resembled the heads of lions, and out of their mouths came fire, smoke and sulfur.

(3) 1/3 of mankind wiped out by these plagues. Rev 9:18 A third of mankind was killed by the three plagues of fire, smoke and sulfur that came out of their mouths. 19 The power of the horses was in their mouths and in their tails; for their tails were like snakes, having heads with which they inflict injury.

3. This pain sadly didn't produce salvation.

Rev 9:20 The rest of mankind who were not killed by these plagues still did not repent . . .

How To Not Follow Jesus

- (1) They loved what they owned & built.
 Rev 9:20 . . . still did not repent of the work of their hands;
- **(2) They loved & worshiped the wrong things.** Rev 9:20 . . . they did not stop worshiping demons,
- (3) They loved money & objects not Jesus.

 Rev 9:20 . . . and idols of gold, silver, bronze, stone and wood—idols that cannot see or hear or walk
- (4) They hated people rather than loved them. Rev 9:20 . . . Nor did they repent of their murders,
- **(5) They believed in** *stupid* **stuff.** Rev 9:20 . . . their magic arts,
- **(6) They made their own** *rules* **with sex.** Rev 9:20 . . . their sexual immorality
- (7) They were not people of *integrity*. Rev 9:20 . . . or their thefts.
