(2) To something publicly. Eph 5:19 Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, 20 always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
(3)thankfulness as a normal Psalm 100:4 Enter His gates with thanksgiving And His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him, bless His name. 5 For the Lord is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting And His faithfulness to all generations.
Best Way To Actually Live Thankful
(1) Make you're to Jesus. John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 10:28 I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish;
no one will snatch them out of my hand.
(2) Learn to life's challenges.

3. Focus on God not things. Heb 12:28 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, 29 for our "God is a consuming fire."
(3) deeply in the pillars in life. Prov 18:24 One who has unreliable friends soon comes to ruin, but there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother.
1. Clearly how you 1 Thess 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing. Rom 12:10 Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one

3. Be a "" person AOAP. Ecc 4:9 Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: 10 If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up.
